Instructions:

1. Find the first person's relationship to the common ancestor by looking across the top (unmarked) row of boxes.
2. Find the second person's relationship to the common ancestor by looking down the left most (unmarked) column of boxes.
3. Read down and across until you reach the box where the two intersect. That box will show the relationship.

Example:

1. Daniel is the common ancestor
2. Bill is Daniel's Great-Great Grandson, so you choose column 4.
3. Yvonne is Daniel's Great-Great Granddaughter, so you choose row 4.
4. Follow down the column 4 and across the row 4 until they intersect.
5. They intersect at the box "3rd Cousin", so Bill and Yvonne are Third Cousins.
